# Here's How...

**Step 1:** Apply for work and receive your certificate of approval. Print it out. It does not need to be printed in color.

**Step 2:** Post your approval on the front of the property, 1st level and clearly visible from the sidewalk, preferably near your building permit.

**Step 3:** Keep the placard posted and visible to the public for the duration of the project.
