Dear Commissioner Fiandaca:

I write on behalf of nuTonomy to inform you that we have met the milestones provided for in Phase B2 of the Test Plan and to respectfully request your approval to begin Phase C.

nuTonomy has now completed over 230 miles of driving in autonomous mode in the Raymond L. Flynn Marine Park. We completed our first 100 miles in January as part of Phase B1 of the Test Plan. On February 14, you approved our request to move onto Phase B2, in which we were asked to drive an additional 100 miles, including driving in the evening and in inclement weather.

On March 2, we completed Phase B2's additional 100-mile target. During Phase B2, we drove approximately 70 of the 100 miles during evening hours. We also drove several miles in rain and in road conditions in which fallen snow was present. We will be sending you more information about our testing in our Quarterly Report.

We now ask your permission to begin Phase C of the Test Plan, which we hope will include an expanded testing area. We greatly appreciate your consideration of our request. Please do not hesitate to contact us if you have any questions about our AV testing. We look forward to hearing back.
